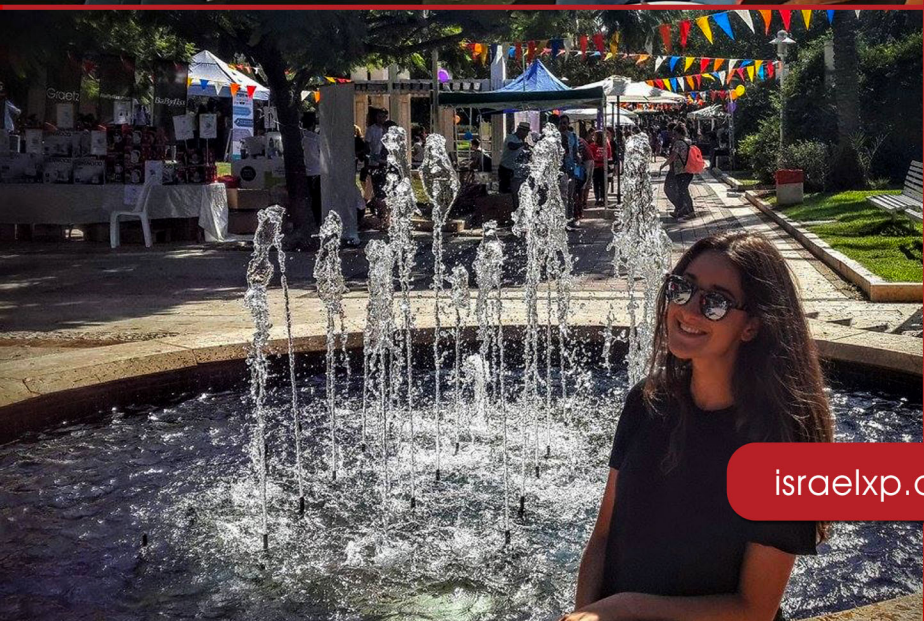

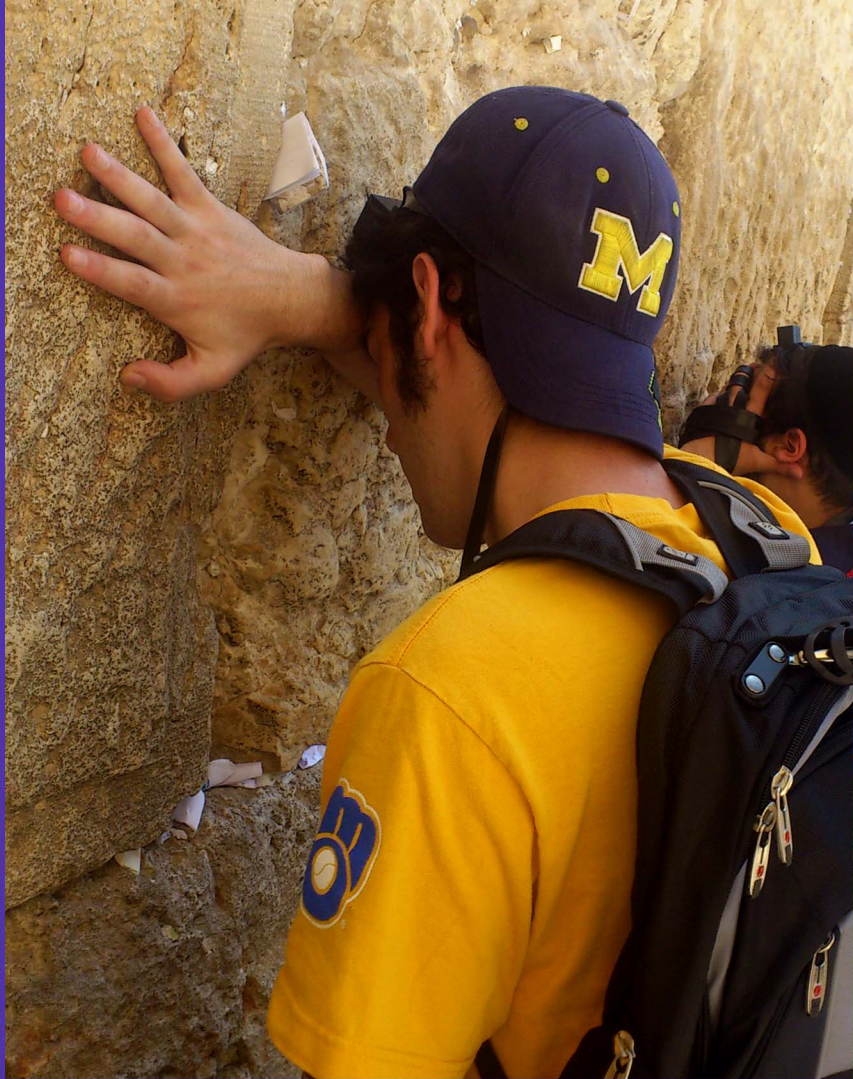

The main requirement is that prospective students be seriously interested in spiritual growth. Students are given the flexibility to grow at their own pace, but must be prepared to observe the program's standards and expectations, including full Torah observance during programming and on campus. Admission requirements include a high school diploma, good SAT or ACT scores, strong academic record, favorable recommendations, and a personal interview with senior staff of the program.
